1 WHEN YOU FIRST LEARNED THAT YOU HAD BEEN SELECTED AS A TEN OUTSTANDING YOUNG PERSON, WHAT WAS THE FIRST THOUGHT THAT CAME TO YOUR MIND?

I was genuinely very happy. The Ten Outstanding Young Persons Award is widely recognized by society, and to me, it represents affirmation not only of individual achievements, but also of long-term dedication and perseverance.

What this award truly conveys is an important message — that society values not only extraordinary accomplishments, but also young people who have quietly committed themselves over time and remained faithful to their beliefs. It reminds us that Hong Kong is a place where diverse forms of contribution are acknowledged, and that itself is deeply meaningful.



2 IF YOU COULD DESCRIBE YOUR CORE LEADERSHIP VALUES IN THREE WORDS, WHAT WOULD THEY BE, AND HOW DO THEY INFLUENCE YOUR DECISIONS?

First, a heart for contribution. I believe a leader must genuinely want to contribute to society. Through this process, we not only create change, but also inspire those around us to move together toward a better society and a better Hong Kong.

Second, commitment to one's beliefs. When pursuing ideals, different opinions, setbacks, and failures are inevitable. At such moments, it is crucial not to doubt yourself but to stay true to what you believe in.

Third, doing one's best. Regardless of the outcome, knowing that you have given your fullest effort is the best accountability to yourself and to those who support you. These three values continue to drive me forward in my service and work.

WHAT HAS BEEN THE MOST CHALLENGING LEADERSHIP EXPERIENCE YOU HAVE FACED, AND HOW DID YOU MAKE YOUR DECISION AT THAT TIME?

Across social service, professional work, and public service, challenges are inevitable. In policy advocacy, particularly, progress often requires both industry support and government confidence, which can be a long and demanding process.

Many initiatives take years to materialize. Early resistance can easily lead to frustration, but persistence in one's convictions is essential. Even when outcomes are uncertain, every attempt is a learning experience that helps refine ideas and shape one's growth as a leader.

WHEN A TEAM FACES FAILURE OR A DIFFICULT PERIOD, WHAT DO YOU BELIEVE IS THE MOST IMPORTANT ROLE OF A LEADER?

First and foremost, a leader must acknowledge and manage emotions — both their own and those of the team. Leadership is not about suppressing emotions, but about addressing them with honesty and empathy.

At the same time, it is important to help the team reflect quickly and learn from the experience. Every setback is an opportunity for improvement, and timely mindset adjustment is key to turning failure into progress.

HOW DO YOU VIEW THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN PERSONAL ACHIEVEMENT AND SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY?

I do not believe there is an inherent conflict between personal growth and social responsibility. When society improves, individuals naturally benefit; when an industry thrives, those within it also progress.

By approaching issues from a broader perspective and working toward outcomes that benefit society as a whole, both tangible and intangible rewards follow. Continued contribution will always be recognized in time.

WHAT ADVICE WOULD YOU GIVE TO YOUNG PEOPLE ASPIRING TO BECOME LEADERS TODAY?

Do not place personal gain as your top priority. Leadership and meaningful impact require time to build. Some results may only become visible after ten or even twenty years.

When I first engaged in social service, I never expected any return. Opportunities often emerge naturally after years of sincere effort. What matters most is staying true to your beliefs and not giving up too easily.


