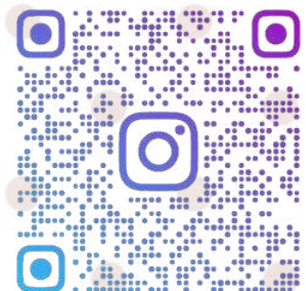
JCI ISLAND INTRODUCTION

COVER INTERVIEW



MR. TSE HOI FAT
 Founder and CEO of Kam Kee Holdings Limited
 2022 Top Outstanding Young Person Awardee

BACKGROUND

Mr. Tse Hoi Fat is the founder and CEO of restaurant group Kam Kee Holdings Limited. Tse graduated in 2005 from The Chinese University of Hong Kong. Like many accounting graduates, he first worked as an auditor, spending about four and a half years between 2005 and 2010 working at KPMG. He started his first business in 2010, Mexican eatery Mr Taco Truck. And started the business of Kam Kee in 2012.

EWAN SJU: According to the information that you grew up in basic level family, how is your childhood? And how can you to be success afterwards?

MR. TSE: Generally, kids at my age used to play video games, watch television, visit parks or theme parks with their parents. When I was a kid, I grew up at Temple Street and it gave me many different memories such as first time entering the police station when I was only at the age of four. It was my first time getting on a police car with my mother. I remember vividly it was the Yau Ma Tei Police Station, it is currently the location of a museum. No 4 year olds could have had entered a police station at this age. (Cont.)



MR. TSE: (Cont.) I think I was rather extraordinary in this case.

When I was 5 years old, I had already come across with drugs as neighbors had showed me and asked if I was interested to take the drugs.

I had the opportunity to approach triads at the age of 6 as our neighborhood is filled with these people all around us.

EWAN SIU: As you mentioned that you grew up in a very bad environment, how come you can be outstanding from them? Any important elements?

MR. TSE: Yes, as previous mentioned, I have seen a lot compared with others (drugs, triad, gambling) and so on. I was not the same as others playing video games.



I just played candles at Mid-Autumn Festival. It made me understand a lot about the society and the characteristics of different people in life. This is very useful. When I grew up facing difficulties in the society, the mindset and the positivity. I heard elder brothers telling me that growing up in Temple Street would not be able to achieve good academic results at school. They were going to be gangsters for sure. Of course, majority of my friends at the neighbourhood grew up in this path due to peer influence; they grew up with hawkers, drug addicts and thieves. I have not joined the triads but I had chatted with them a lot, played chess with them and interacted with them; meanwhile, I saw my parents were very hard working. They worked even under typhoon signal No.8. I learnt "The harder you work, the more you get" from them, which is also one of the key element on my path.

EWAN SIU: Could you share your tips to our members that how can you balance your career, social affair and your family?

MR. TSE: Firstly, you have to understand that you can't take everything on your own. Whether it's career or social affairs, it's important to build your own team. However, startup always begins with 'one-man band", this is the most difficult period of time where everyone faces. You have to strive and work hard for the first few years before you have your own team. When your company or your social posts has a team to support you, your time management will be better. Of course, if you have to involve in social affairs, you have to sacrifice time on family and leisure time. For example, you have to sacrifice your after work hours for meetings and dinner if you take up social affairs posts. Therefore, whether it's startup or social affairs, your personal time will lessen hence you will not spend a lot of time with your family. Therefore, you have to take a balance between the two. Family members may not understand what you are doing, so you may invite them to activities so they can learn more about social affairs and be supportive and considerate. Merging three things together would be easier: work, career and social affairs.

When I was young, I wanted to start my own business and I thought that if I were going to do so, accounting would be the basic stuff that I need; that's why I picked accounting in university,

EWAN SUI: Youth in Hong Kong experienced pandemic and the social issue in 2019, any encouraging words for them?

MR. TSE: 10 – 20 years later, these things are only small issues. 1 year in 100 years is just a short period of time. There will always be a way out or opportunities when we face challenges or difficulties, the path will not always be straight. We have to grasp our opportunities, like the Canto pop song: Hong Kong is a good place, we should focus on the current and future. There is not right timing but the positive mindset is very important. We have to stay positive and we will always be successful.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

Flash back to 2022, according to 'The Future of Jobs 2020' published by World Economic Forum, report by **McKinsey & Company** and street interview done by us, we found that future skill is necessary for youths but only few of them know. Future skills can be grouped in 4 categories: Cognitive, Interpersonal, Self-leadership and Digital.

According to the positive feedback on "LEAD to the future 2022", there are nearly 600 universities students applications for the competition and over 100 working people attended the workshops, which reflected the project can attract the students participation and make impacts to them.

Regarding the plan of next year, we would like to base on the future skills, which is the emphasis in 2022, focus on **ESG** and **Fintech**. Digital reformation is a trend in future, especially in post pandemic era, the adaptability of technology are highly enhanced. Technology is the key of future, teaching them about technology can definitely help for preparing future development. This year, we would stage various workshops of Future skills and mainly explore about the digital. Also, we will have a case competition for application of the knowledge learnt in the workshops.

"Super Kid Study" has in three parts.

(1) A local survey on identifying future skills and future talent's characters from Hong Kong people's perspective. Meanwhile, an international research will be studied the education systems among six countries.

(2) Seminars: future skills vs our current education system & current parenting in Hong Kong; International trip among Asian Pacific to discuss the education styles among different countries.

(3) Free courses (義教) on future skills to the students from low-income families. These courses are created by JCI Island with the support from Principal Chan Free Tutorial World (HKCNC) and other ten primary school.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

- ✓ To understand what are perceived as future skills and future talents from Hong Kong people's perspective
- ✓ To share with Hong Kong parents on the direction of education
- ✓ To provide free courses (義教) about inspiring future skills to the students, specially the low-income families

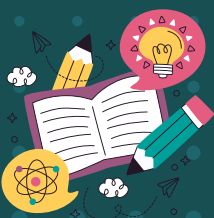

JC SPORTS DAY



No one will deny that the out-breaking of Covid-19 was already changed our living pattern. After the pandemic, the social policy limited our social distance, which induced both physical and mental health problems . Obviously, sports is one of the most effective solution to improve this problem to Hong Kong people.

It began in 2005 when JCI Island saw a vision to promote an active lifestyle, which marks the birth of the JC Sports Day. The JC Sports Day not only brings together all members from all JCI chapters in Hong Kong, but also promotes cooperation between team members through competition. The first event was held on 24 April 2005, with subsequent events held every year afterwards. The event mainly includes track events from 100 m to 1500 m runs, as well as field events like high jump, long jump and shot put.

With the impact of Covid-19 for three years, previous JC sports day was held in 2019. In 2023, JC Sports Day will be back. The event will be held on 1 May 2023. The organising of the event has started in late 2022. The organising committee are mainly comprised of the members and advisors from JCI Island.
